Things to Ask So You Can Give Informed Consent

- 1. What is the problem?
- 2. What are the symptoms, or test results that are causing concern? Could this be normal?
- 3. What is the most likely cause? Are there any other possible causes?
- 4. Why does my baby, or why do I need this drug or procedure?
- 5. Will my baby and I be healthier for taking it, or having it done? Is this part of a study, a routine, merely for convenience, part of insurance guidelines or a true emergency?
- 6. What are its known side effects or liabilities?
- 7. Will its benefits outweigh the side effects?
- 8. What tests or monitoring will be done? What do these show and what levels are we looking for? Will your treatment be different after the results are known?
- 9. Are there other options? What is the risk to me and my baby if I don't take it or have it done?
- 10. Weigh the risks vs the benefits. All drugs and procedures have risks and benefits.
